Year 7 Curriculum Overview – Trinity Term 2018

English	Writing - non-fiction and fiction, writing for purpose & poetry – language of Shakespeare Comprehension - Fiction and non-fiction texts 12+ and moving to 13+ papers Oral - speech, debates + background of Shakespeare Class Reader: 'A Midsummer Night's Dream' – by William Shakespeare
Maths	Area, perimeter and volume of compound shapes including trapezia and cylinders, Rounding and estimating, Constructions and bearings including angles, transformations, exam revision, handling data, algebra, sequences. Level 2 Calculator work for 7X1.
Science	The Earth & beyond Elements & Compounds. Plant reproduction
Geography	Industry (Economic activities). Tectonic Processes. Revision of Year 7 topics
History	Mary I – religion, marriage and the burnings Elizabeth I – problems facing Elizabeth, religion and marriage
Music	Recognising instruments; key signatures; continued recognition of notes; <i>Aurelia</i> and <i>Musition</i> software. Preparation for <i>Pandemonium</i> .
Religious Education	Study of Christianity: Christian Beliefs; The Bible; Prayer; Sacraments; Church Services; Christian Ministers; Christian Festivals; Pilgrimage.
Computing	Typing and PIXLAR Photo editing
PSHCE	Pupil Council CITIZENSHIP: Keeping safe, First Aid ECONOMIC: Spending and saving
French	7X2: Expo3 Vert: talk about TV and films, description of yourself and others, reading preferences, last weekend, planning ahead, the future and future careers 7X1: Expo 3 Rouge: talk about TV and films, daily routine, reading preferences, descriptions of events (present, past and future) planning ahead, the future and future careers
Spanish	Mira 1 – Unit 5: time, freetime activities, sports, plans for the next week-end, week etc. Grammar: conjugation of the verbs "ir" "gustar", preferir, immediate future tense with "ir"
Latin	Personal Pronouns. Revision of 5 tenses. Translation from and into Latin. Comparison of adjectives. Familiarity with CE papers. A revision of the Greek alphabet and verb endings of the present tense. Greek mythology includes a revision of the Greek epics: <i>Jason & The Argonauts</i> and <i>The Odyssey</i> .
DT	Construct an electronic recording device. Students develop their soldering skills learnt from the speaker project, and continue to learn about new components and their functions.
Art	Clay work. Artist study and group art work.
PE	Athletics: pupils taught the correct technique for each event and assessed in line with the STG award scheme. Track events: sprints, 3/400m, hurdles, distance, relays. Field events: high jump, long jump, shot putt, javelin [selected pupils only].

Boys' Games	CRICKET: Team selection (1st & 2 nd XI). Fielding skills, bowling technique, batting. Fielding positions. Running between wickets and communication. Hard ball - timed / limited over game. Tennis will also be played on occasions.
Girls' Games	ROUNDERS: Throwing - pick up and throw to a base in one continuous movement. Catching - moving into correct position to catch and return. Bowling stance and variety of speeds, consistency and accuracy. Fielding - teamwork and response to situations, picking up on the run and returning. Hitting - directing the ball to different locations. Developing an understanding of the importance of bowling towards a batter in a location that is difficult to hit. CRICKET: introduction to the basic cricket skills of batting/bowling/fielding and match play
