

2nd Hand Uniform

St. George's **2nd Hand Uniform** is a great way to recycle **quality outgrown uniform**. It also enables valuable funds to be raised for the St. George's Parents' Group which go directly to benefit the children and school.

HOW TO BUY

The **2nd Hand Uniform Shop** is open on **Tuesday mornings 8:30-10:00am** (term time only), coinciding with the main School Uniform Shop where it is located. It is run by parent helpers, on behalf of the St. George's School Parents' Group.

Sale Events are also held during the year, the main and largest of which is an Autumn/Winter uniform sale held in the Summer term. Extra shop opening times are also offered in the Spring term for the purchase of Summer uniform.

The **2nd Hand Uniform Price List** is available here on the school website. Please note - all payments are by **CASH** or **CHEQUE only** and items are **NON-refundable**.

HOW TO SELL

Only official items of School and Ballet uniform can be sold. We do not accept discontinued uniform, footwear, swimwear, socks/tights or Year 3+ blouses/shirts. Uniform must be in **good condition, freshly laundered/dry cleaned** and **undamaged**, otherwise, it will be recycled within the school community or donated to charity.

How profits work

School uniform is sold on a 70/30 basis – 70% to the seller and 30% donated to the St. George's School Parents' Group. 100% of the profits from Ballet uniform sales are given to the Ballet Group operating within the School, as a contribution towards their annual Ballet Show.

If you wish to **DONATE** your profits, please **remove** all name labels. Otherwise, **ALL** items must be **clearly labelled**, ideally with parent's name and contact details, but **ATLEAST THE CHILD'S NAME**, if you want any profits to be returned to you.

Seller profits are issued **annually**, during the summer holidays, via electronic transfer to your nominated bank account. It is **essential** that you provide an up to date **BANK ACCOUNT NAME, NUMBER** and **SORT CODE** plus **CONTACT NAME** and **MOBILE NUMBER** to enable any profits to be returned to you. Please put these details in a sealed envelope marked for '2nd Hand Uniform' and give directly to the School Office when you drop off your items.

Dropping uniform off

Label your bags of uniform '2nd Hand Uniform' and leave at the School Office or just outside the 2nd Hand Uniform shop door. Don't forget your contact and bank details!

Upon receipt, items will be checked for quality, then priced. 2nd Hand pricing is based on **one third of the cost of new uniform** but may be tiered to reflect item quality between 'good' and 'immaculate' condition. Items will be offered for sale for 24 months, after which we reserve the right to recycle unsold items.
